North Haven to Hold Annual Trunk or Treat Halloween Event

North Haven's Chief Elected Official, Michael J. Freda announced that North Haven will again hold a Halloween "Trunk or Treat" event for North Haven residents on Saturday, October 24th, 2015 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm in the North Haven High School parking lot located at 221 Elm Street.

Halloween Trunk-or-Treat provides a safe environment for families to enjoy Halloween fun. Costumed children trick-or-treat outdoors by going from car trunk to car trunk to get their bag filled with goodies. This event is for North Haven residents only: be prepared to show proof of residence – license or registration. For safety reasons, **PARTICIPANTS MUST ARRIVE BEFORE 6:00 pm AND REMAIN PARKED FOR THE ENTIRE 2 HOURS UNTIL 8:00 PM. There will be no car traffic during the event for the safety of the children trick or treating. Adults must accompany children – No drop offs!** Parents may feel free to decorate their trunks and cars. Children should be wearing costumes. No alcoholic beverages permitted. There is no charge to participate. From past experience, we expect a high turnout and therefore suggest you bring plenty of candy to share with trick or treaters.

"We continue to receive a lot of interest in this event", stated Michael J. Freda, First Selectman. "This has proved to be a fun night for families in Town, and we are pleased to be able to offer it again this year", added Freda.
