Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the April 22, 2008 regular meeting and executive session. A motion was made by Commissioner McLoughlin to approve, second by Commissioner Monz. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to approve the monthly reports for April. A motion was made by Commissioner Monz to approve, second by Commissioner McLoughlin. Motion passed unanimously.

CORRESPONDENCE – A resident thanked the police officers who monitored his home while he was away for several days.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Chief will consult with the Department of Transportation regarding “no turn right on red” traffic signal on Universal Drive and Sackett Point Road – consider removal.

The Department will look at the “no turn right on red” traffic signal on Elm Street and Sackett Point Road to consider removal.

Chief will find out whose responsibility it is to repair huge potholes on the private driveway between Boston Market and Tommy K's.

CHIEF'S REPORT

The Commission will interview six applicants for the position of patrol officer in executive session.

Sick and accident on the job – none.

No new grievances.

The department received patrol equipment on Friday May 23, 2008 from two different vendors. The equipment is on loan for 120 days. The equipment includes laser unit, speed trailer, and stealth box for traffic volume and radar. Since the budget passed we will be

able to purchase a speed trailer and laser and radar unit. The equipment on loan will be evaluated side by side and the vendors will submit a bid.

Bids will be accepted in August-September for four new cruisers.

The department will continue strict radar enforcement.

Chief reported that Deputy Chief was instrumental in planning and carrying out the police recruit testing process. It was very successful. Lieutenants Lofquist, Remington and Mulhern, and Sergeant Mahon served as panelists and screeners.

The police union is in negotiations with the town labor attorney and acting Finance Director Edward Gomeau. Chief gave his input on operational issues and is satisfied with the communications with the town.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to move into executive session to discuss personal matters. A motion was made by Commissioner McLoughlin, second by Commissioner Calafiore. Motion passed unanimously. The time was 7:15 P.M.

The Commission reconvened into regular session at 9:35 P.M.

A motion was made by Commissioner Calafiore to offer a conditional offer of employment to applicant Matthew Jordan and second by Commissioner McLoughlin. Motion passed unanimously. This conditional offer given to Matthew Jordan is contingent upon him successfully passing a medical examination and drug screening, a psychological examination, a polygraph examination, extensive background check, and the passing of the COOPER Standards tests as prescribed by POSTC.
