Regular Meeting
June 23, 2009

Chairman D'Errico called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Present: Chairman D'Errico, Commissioners Monz, Lazaroff and McLoughlin, Chief DiCarlo, and Deputy Chief McLoughlin.

Absent: Commissioner Calafiore.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the May 27, 2009 regular meeting and executive session. A motion to approve was made by Commissioner McLoughlin, second by Commissioner Monz. The motion passed unanimously.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to approve the monthly reports for May. A motion to approve was made by Commissioner Lazaroff, second by Commissioner McLoughlin. The motion passed unanimously.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. The Director of South Central Criminal Justice Administration thanked the Chief for allowing Sergeant DePalma and Sergeant Mahon to serve as panelists at an oral board examination.
2. A class advisor at Eli Whitney Technical High School thanked Officer Mills for the vigilant, attentive and polite manner he showed while working at the senior class prom at Fantasia.

Old business – New carpeting has been installed in the conference room and administrative offices on the first floor. The remainder of the renovations will begin in July.

New business – Officer Stanley Girard will retire on July 3, 2009 after over 25 years with the police department. Chief DiCarlo said he is a conscientious, trustworthy and dependable officer who did a great job. Officer Girard was presented with a plaque, retirement badge and a gold watch.

Chief's Report – The commission will interview three candidates this evening and hire one officer to replace retiring Officer Girard.

One officer is off on long term injury.

The DUI enforcement program will run from July 2-4, 2009. The town is reimbursed 75% of the cost by the Department of Transportation.

Numerous radar surveys have been conducted. The speed trailer will be used around town to remind drivers to slow down. The stealth unit will monitor traffic volume and speed.

Commissioner McLoughlin said four North Haven officers were recognized in June by MADD. Commissioner McLoughlin said it speaks very highly of the officers.

Deputy Chief McLoughlin said the department has reserved one seat at the police academy for October 2009.

Officer Rienzo is in his fifth week of field training.

The federal stimulus grants are pending. The department should get the results in late August. Chairman D'Errico said the purchase of equipment is done through grants with no cost to the taxpayers.

Both bicycle and motorcycle patrols began in May.

Commissioner McLoughlin congratulated Chief DiCarlo for bringing the budget in on target this year.

A police officer commendation awards ceremony is tentatively scheduled for September.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to adjourn and move into executive session to discuss personnel matters. A motion was made by Commissioner McLoughlin and second by Commissioner Monz. The motion passed unanimously. The time was 7:50pm.

The Commission reconvened into regular session at 9:25pm.

A motion was made by Commissioner McLoughlin to offer a conditional offer of employment to applicant Marc Ruggiero and second by Commissioner Monz. The motion passed unanimously. This conditional offer given to Marc Ruggiero is contingent upon him successfully passing a medical examination and drug screening, a psychological examination, a polygraph examination, extensive background check and the passing of the COOPER Standards tests as prescribed by POSTC.

The remaining applicants were ranked in the following order and will be called up for the conditional offer if required.
