Chief DiCarlo distributed an article written by Sergeant Marc Fasano that appeared in the North Haven Citizen. Chief said it is an excellent article that discusses all aspects of drugs. Chief will contact the Connecticut Police Chiefs Association about printing the article in their newsletter. Copies will be made available for parents and students.

CHIEF'S REPORT

The School Resource Officer program is in its second week. The DARE program will continue for 5th graders.

Lieutenant Jonathan Mulhern will graduate from the FBI National Academy on September 18th and report back to work on September 21st.

Chief met with members of the Peters Rock Association to discuss enforcement strategies for all terrain vehicles, dirt bikes and vandalism at the park. A tremendous amount of damage has been done to the park. Enforcement will be stepped up with zero tolerance. Adult children will be issued a fine infraction ticket. Tickets will be issued to the parents of children. The vehicle will be towed at owners' expense.

Deputy Chief McLoughlin reported the SWAT team did very well at the Connecticut SWAT Challenge in September.

Firearms training is scheduled for the fall.
