Chairman D'Errico called the meeting to order at 6:05pm.

Present: Chairman D'Errico, Commissioners Monz, Calafiore and Lazaroff, Chief DiCarlo and Deputy Chief McLoughlin.

Absent: Commissioner McLoughlin

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to move into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing personnel issues relating to promotions.

The motion was made by Commissioner Monz, second by Commissioner Lazaroff and all were in favor. The time was 6:06pm.

At 6:12pm, the Commission returned to Regular Session for the purpose of voting on promotions.

Commissioner Monz made a motion to promote Officer John Scarpa and Officer Christopher Thorpe, in that order, to the rank of Sergeant effective March 22, 2011. A second was made by Commissioner Lazaroff and all were in favor.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to return to Executive Session for the purpose of interviewing candidates for the position of patrol officer.

The motion was made by Commissioner Lazaroff, second by Commissioner Calafiore and all were in favor. The time was 6:15pm.

At 8:20pm the Commission adjourned from Executive Session and returned to Regular Session for the purpose of voting on conditional offers of employment.

Candidates for employment were ranked as follows:

- 3.) John Gaspar
- 4.) Louis Decrescenzo
- 5.) Anthony Sandagata

Commissioner Monz made a motion that Michael DiCocco, Maurice Martin and John Gaspar, in that particular order, be given conditional offers of employment for the position of patrolman. Being that DiCocco, Martin and Gaspar are certified police officers in Connecticut; these offers are contingent upon the successful passing of a medical examination, substance abuse screening, polygraph examination, Cooper examination and a background check.

A second was made by Lazaroff and all were in favor.

Commissioner Monz made a motion that should either DiCocco, Martin or Gaspar be unavailable, or if they fail to meet all employment standards, that a conditional offer of employment be made to applicants Louis Decrescenzo and Anthony Sandagata, in that particular order. Being that Decrescenzo and Sandagata are certified police officers in Connecticut, these offers are contingent upon the successful passing of a medical examination, substance abuse screening, a polygraph examination, Cooper examination and a background check.

Second by Commissioner Calafiore and all were in favor.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Calafiore, second by Lazaroff and all were in favor.
