### Board of Police Commission Regular Meeting July 26, 2011

Chairman D'Errico called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

Present: Chairman D'Errico, Commissioners McLoughlin, Lazaroff, and Calafiore, Chief McLoughlin, Deputy Chief Mulhern, and Kevin Fletcher from NHTV.

Absent: Commissioner Monz.

The first order of business was the approval of the minutes for the June 28, 2011 regular meeting and executive session. A motion to accept was made by Commissioner McLoughlin, second by Commissioner Lazaroff. The motion passed unanimously.

The next order of business was the approval of the monthly reports for June. A motion to accept was made by Commissioner Calafiore, second by Commissioner Lazaroff. The motion passed unanimously.

#### CORRESPONDENCE

1. The family of Bill Dobbins, retired NHFD, thanked the department for their assistance and support during Bill's illness, passing and memorial service.
2. A resident thanked the department and especially Chief McLoughlin, Detective Guidone, Detective Wilcox, Officer Onofrio, Officer Stockmon, Officer Sordi, Captain Genovese and Detective Falcon for their help and support after a burglary.
3. A resident thanked Officer Queiroga for the services he performed for him.
4. Two area women thanked Lieutenant Glenn for his help and patience in assisting them with cell phone issues.
5. A resident thanked School Resource Officer Falcon and Officer O'Keefe for their recent handling of thefts from the North Haven Middle School.
6. Kevin Doyle, Senior Assistant State's Attorney thanked Detective Guidone and Detective Wilcox for all of their efforts that resulted in the successful resolution of large scale fraudulent scams on banks and businesses.

#### CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

Chairman D'Errico commented on the police pension fund and the refurbished classroom that will eventually be the Police Commission Room and Training Room in honor of former Police Chairman Paul Abercrombie.

#### CHIEF'S REPORT

Chief McLoughlin warned residents to lock windows, doors, and car doors due to a spike in residential non-forced entry burglaries. He asked residents to call the department if they see something suspicious.

The police department budget for FY 2010-2011 was 1.4% under budget.

The two new recruits will report to the police academy on August 12th for 22 weeks of training. When they report back to the department they will receive 10 weeks of field training.

Line painting will begin in September after street paving is complete.

The new firearms are beginning to arrive and one new cruiser has also been delivered. Three more police cruisers are expected to be delivered in the beginning of September.

Chief reported that K-9 Zeus received his body armor and once again thanked Theresa Maresca who donated the money for the vest. Mrs. Maresca met K-9 Zeus and his handler Officer James Brennan and photos were taken.

Chief reported a good response to the Public Safety Day that was held on July 9<sup>th</sup>. Future safety days are under consideration and may be held next year in October in conjunction with Fire Prevention Week.

Walter T. Berniere Scholarship Award – Chief asked for a motion to approve a scholarship award for Detective Mark Guidone for two courses he completed at POST University. A motion to approve the award was made by Commissioner McLoughlin, second by Commissioner Lazaroff. The motion passed unanimously.

Deputy Chief Mulhern reported training recertifications are ahead of schedule. Detective Harton and Detective Wilcox have been trained in NCIS Linx Data Sharing and the system is up and running. It is a secured system with access through certain points and people.

James Fasanella was sworn in as a police officer by Chairman D'Errico at 7:50pm.

Nicholas Costanzo was sworn in as a police officer by Chairman D'Errico at 7:55pm.

The Commission congratulated them and wished them well.

There was no business to be discussed for an executive session.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner McLoughlin made the motion, second by Commissioner Calafiore. The motion passed unanimously. The time was 8:00pm.
