**Correspondence:**

A letter was received from Mike Maglione; Director of Public Safety for the City of Shelton thanking Deputy Chief Mulhern for his assistance in a recent exam for the position of Police Captain.

**Chairman's Report:**

Old business: Chairman had nothing to report.

New Business:

Chairman thanked the Chief, Deputy and the whole Police Department for their efforts and assistance during the latest winter storms.

Chairman D'Errico said that he felt the Budget workshop on February 18th went well and the Chief and Deputy did a great job and he felt that the Board of Finance appreciates the way the Police Administration handle the funds.

**Chiefs Report:**

Chief reminds residents and all commercial businesses to be aware of the sidewalk ordinance which allows 24 hours after a snow storm to clear your sidewalks and walkways. For public safety he encourages everyone to follow this ordinance.

Chief said they are currently right on target regarding the budget. Chief said the budget workshop on the 18<sup>th</sup> was well received. He stated he didn't ask for a lot on the operational issues, but he explained to the board that there are some big ticket items on capital end, not so much for the coming year but spread out over the next 5 years. Chief said that these items are building maintenance issues.

Chief mentioned that he is over budget right now on the Traffic Maintenance line due to having to pay for the replacement of two traffic lights. Chief said he hopes that the insurance reimbursement will be put back in to his traffic maintenance line and not the general fund.

### **Support Services /Traffic**

Regarding the subject of signage placement on Hartford Turnpike from the last meeting, Chief advised the Commission that the request has been sent to the State DOT and the homeowner has been advised. The state will review it, and if they feel the signage is necessary they would most likely put it up in the spring when the ground thaws.

### **Training**

Officer Dahlstrom is almost done with his ten weeks of field training. Recruit Pacileo is half way through the Police Academy and graduation will be at the end of April. Pacileo should be complete with his ten weeks of field training by mid-summer.

### **Uniformed Services**

Regarding patrol activity the numbers are lower this month for calls for service as well as enforcement issues mainly due to the bad weather winter.

### **Walter T. Berniere Scholarship**

There were no Walter T. Berniere Scholarship requests this month.

Chief had nothing more for regular session.

With no further discussion, Chairman asked for a motion to adjourn to move into Executive session for the purpose of discussing personnel.

The motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Calafiore; seconded by Commissioner Monz. All were in favor. The time was 7:38p.m.
