Commissioner Lazaroff made a motion to move to Executive session for the purpose of interviewing the following police applicants:

Thomas Murray
James O'Donoghue

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Spader. All were in favor.

At 7:54 p.m. the Commission reconvened to Regular Session for the purposes of voting.

Commissioner Lazaroff made a motion to extend a conditional offer of employment to Thomas Murray; who is currently a certified Police Officer in Connecticut for the position of patrol officer contingent on the following:

1. Successfully pass a polygraph examination, if needed.
2. Successfully pass a psychological examination, if needed.
3. Successfully pass an in-depth background investigation.
4. Successfully pass an entry level medical examination.
5. Successfully pass a substance abuse screening examination.
6. Successfully pass the Cooper Standard as administered by POSTC.

Further, if Mr. Murray was unable to meet these conditions, the offer would be withdrawn and the same offer of employment would be made to James O'Donoghue.

Commissioner Spader seconded this motion and all were in favor.

Chairman D'Errico asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Spader, seconded by Commissioner Lazaroff. All were in favor.
