Commissioner Monz made a motion that if Daniel Wheeler was unable to meet these conditions, the offer would be withdrawn and the same conditional offer of employment would be made to the other applicants in the following order:

2. Jesse Prajer

A second was made by Commissioner Spader and all were in favor.
