

NORTH HAVEN HOUSING AUTHORITY June 7, 2011

Chairman DellaValle called the June 7, 2011 meeting to order at 4:00pm. Commissioner Cook was absent and excused.

Upon proper motions made and seconded the May minutes were approved as was payment of the June bills as well as any ordinary bills through July and August.

Correspondence included notification of various meetings and the NAHRO convention, Blumenthal's disclaimer, a letter of complaint from a tenant regarding hall storage and e-mails regarding the "Tenant's Bill of Rights.

The commissioners unanimously voted to refuse the weatherization grant, ie the installation of heat pumps.

It was decided that storm doors would be replaced as needed.

The administrator has purchased a lap top.

A group of housing administrators, RSCs and the director of the Senior Center have formulated a group designed to have cohesiveness in assisting the town's elderly population.

ACES has not yet repaired our fence which was damaged by their snow removal people.

A list of meeting dates and the annual report has been submitted to the Town.

Margaret Wells announced her resignation from the Authority as of this meeting. Mr. Freda will be notified.

B1 at Parkside will be rented to Rosalie Mancini, a Branford resident with North Haven ties.

AT&T has not replaced their circuitry as yet.
