**Household Hazardous Waste Collections Center**  
**Regional Water Authority, 90 Sargent Drive, New Haven**

As you may be aware, the Town of North Haven is one of the 16 participating Town's in the Regional Water Authority's (RWA) Haz Waste Central Collection Program every summer - starting from mid-May and ending in mid-October annually.

This program allows Town residents at NO COST to bring their hazardous materials and wastes to the New Haven facility located on 90 Sargent Drive in New Haven for disposal purposes.

Each year the RWA asks Town's for up to 8 volunteers two Saturday's a season to assist them with the collection of Haz Waste. Volunteers typically check photo identification; log in which vehicles come in from which Town's and so on. Volunteers do not work with actual hazardous materials or wastes.

North Haven's 2016 Volunteer weekends, include:

Saturday, July 9, 2016 - from 9 a.m. to 12 noon; and

Saturday, October 1, 2016 - from 9 a.m. to 12 noon.

Public Works is asking folks to volunteer for this effort and North Haven High School students do receive Community Service credits for such efforts (9 a.m. to 12 noon) for the specified days of work.
