Dispose of cleaning and baby wipes, latex items, and personal hygiene products in the wastebasket. In addition, kitchen grease, cotton swabs, rags, towels, sponges, kitty litter or aquarium gravel, plastic or latex items, hair, and needles can all clog pipes and should be bagged or contained and placed in the trash.
